Next H.O.A. Meeting

The next meeting of the Northridge Heights H.O.A. will be on Tuesday, December 16, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. at NHC President Ed Parada's home located at 19911 Mid Pines Lane Porter Ranch.

Status of Pool and Entry Projects

Over the last several years, and especially since the collapse of the trellises at the front of the community in July of 2007, residents have expressed concerns about the declining conditions of the pool decks, pool plaster, downed trellises and lopped off pilasters where the wooden trellises once stood. At October's board meeting bids were reviewed for work relating to these projects as well as for the remodeling of the entire main entrance. Once the pool projects are complete, before the 2009 swim season, both pool areas will have new plaster and decking. Once the remodeling of the main entrance is complete, part of the guardhouse and part of the pool houses will be refaced with a rock façade and the entry pilasters, as well as the pilasters where the trellises stood, will be reshaped into ledge stone columns. This work will modernize the look of our community and help match the architectural styles of the guardhouse building and the pool houses structures. The first phase of the entry project should be complete even before this newsletter is released, but the second phase won't be completed until 2009 or 2010. Although the pool plastering bids and the pool decking bids were reviewed, only the bids related to the entry pilasters and entry redesign were approved. Also approved was the general liability insurance policy and so was the earthquake policy. The board agreed to meet during the month to discuss and implement brush clearance standards for the community which was a concern for many residents.
